SCHEDULE A

Issues to be dealt with by a separate Full Bench – Pastoral Award 2010

Item	Party	Clause	Description
1	NFF	18	Insert new annual salaries provision
2	NFF	31.2	Amend clause 31.2 as follows: The rate of pay for overtime for a Farm and livestock hand will be time and a half, except on Sunday when the rate will be double time, except in the case of <i>milking</i> , feeding and watering stock when such work will be paid for at the rate of time and a half.
3	AWU	41.2	Insert new subclause 41.2 as follows: “All ordinary hours worked by employees on Saturday shall be paid at the rate of time and a half. All ordinary hours worked by employees on Sunday shall be paid at the rate of double time, except in the case of feeding or watering the stock when such work will be paid for at the rate of time and a half.”
4	AWU	42.3	Amend clause 42.3 to read: “For crutching stud ewes and their lambs – one and a quarter of the rates prescribed in clause 45.2(a). For crutching rams and ram stags – double the rates prescribed in clause 45.2(a).”
5	AWU	44.4	Insert new learner conditions for shearers
